

Bylaws of Comprehensive Examination

1. Types of Exam

- A. Written Test
- B. Other : Refer to the exemption rule

2. Exam Qualification

- A. M.A. : 12 or more credits, 3.0 or higher GPA
- B. Ph.D. : 21 or more credits, 3.0 or higher GPA
- * Only major subjects are counted as necessary credits. (Research Guidance, prerequisite or advisor designated courses are not counted)
- * Regardless of language exam result, students can take the comprehensive exam.

3. Exam Courses

- A. Specialized areas : English teaching and learning theory, British & American literature education and applied linguistics
- B. Designated exam courses : Refer to English education website's announcement

Specialized area : 2 courses + Other area : 1 course	Specialized area : 3 courses + Other area : 1 course

4. Application Form Issue and Submission

- A. Period : Refer to English education website's announcement
- B. Place : Online application
- C. Online application : KUPID > Registration & Graduation > Application/Verification for exams > Application for Comprehensive Exam – Students should fill out the application form for comprehensive exam(written/other) carefully and submit it.

5. Time and Place of Written Test

6. Announcement of Successful Applicants

* Be able to check individually on KUPID

7. Comprehensive Examination Exemption

A. As one publishes an article related to one's own specialized area to an academic association/institute indexed by the National Research Foundation.

-> KCI level : M.A. : 1 / Ph.D. : 2

*If Ph.D. student publishes article as the sole author within one's specialized area of research, 3 specialized area exam courses will be exempt. But student should take 1 exam course in other area.

-> A&HCI, SSCI, or SCI level : M.A. : 1 / Ph.D. : 1

*If Ph.D. student publishes article as the sole author, student will also be exempt from the article required for graduation.

B. If M.A. and Ph.D student publish articles to the academic journals, they must submit a certificate form of publishing paper to our English Language Education office after registering comprehensive exam on the portal system as "[other]" during comprehensive exam registration period.
